NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE FOR SAN JOSE WATER COMPANY'S GENERAL RATE CASE APPLICATION NO. 18-01-004, DECISION NO. 18-11-025 AND ADVICE LETTER 541

San Jose Water (SJW) filed General Rate Case Application (A.) 18-01-004 with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting authority for an increase in revenues of \$34,288,100 (or 9.76 %) in 2019, \$14,231,800 (or 3.70%) in 2020, and \$20,581,700 (or 5.17%) in 2021. In Decision (D.) 18-11-025, the CPUC approved a revenue increase of \$16,378,000 (or 4.55%) for 2019 and anticipated revenue increases of \$12,066,000 (or 3.20%) for 2020 and \$11,713,000 (or 3.01%) for 2021.

SJW filed Advice Letter 541 on November 21, 2019, requesting the 2020 revenue increase as authorized in D.18-11-025. The filing seeks an increase of \$8,600,000 (or 2.28%) for 2020.

CUSTOMER IMPACT

If approved by the CPUC, SJW customers would see the following increases to the monthly service charge and changes to usage rates per ccf.

Typical residential customers with a 3/4-inch meter using 11 ccfs per month will see a monthly bill increase of \$2.02 (or 2.09%) from \$96.80 at present rates, to \$98.82 in 2020. **The amounts shown on your water bill may vary from the dollar amounts shown above due to temporary credits or surcharges in effect.**

Protests and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
