The Commission has approved San Jose Water Company's Advice Letter No. 541, filed on November 22, 2019, regarding the Step Rate Increase for 2020 Escalation Year.

Although this request is being approved, Water Division notes that the advice letter was filed late on November 22, 2019, rather than its due date under Decision No. 18-11-025 which was November 15, 2019. Due to the diligent work of staff, Water Division was able to process this filing and approve it prior to the January 1, 2020 effective date. #### Service Charges:

Currently effective monthly service charge for the applicable meter size as reflected in "Schedule No. 1, General Metered Service".

# SPECIAL CONDITIONS

 For the purposes of this tariff a well user is defined as a customer of the Santa Clara Valley Water District who procures his/her non-potable supply from an on-site well as of the <u>first effective date of this tariff</u>. The service charge for well users will be in accordance with the following schedule:
