San Jose Water Company (U-168-W) (SJWC) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in tariff schedules applicable to its service area and which are attached hereto:

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Orders Nos. 96-B Water Industry Rule 7.3.3(11) and Water Industry Rule 8.7.

The purpose of this advice letter is to request authority from the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to withdraw service to an existing SJWC customer on parcel APN#491-36-001.

Summary

Parcel APN #491-36-001 is a business facility wholly within SJWC's service area that currently does not have its own service line. It has been served for the past 35 years through a shared service with the adjacent mobile home park who is a SJWC customer. The owner of parcel APN #491-36-001 is now looking to establish its own service. SJWC does not have a main in the vicinity that can serve this customer individually. In order provide service to this lot, the owner will have to hook up to SJWC main but this will require significant trenching as well as easements from adjacent properties (mobile home or airport). This is too costly and inefficient for the customer.

The adjacent water system, San Jose Municipal Water System (SJMWS), has a main in front of this property on Tully Road and can provide service without the significant trenching and easements required. Given the efficiency involved for all parties, SJWC is agreeable to allowing the SJMWS to serve this lot.

Effective Date

SJWC requests an effective date of May 23, 2024.

Protests and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- 1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- 2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- 4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- 5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- 6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period. Public notice is not required.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.


